

2.3m Curved Wall: Artwork dimensions

Aim: To provide instruction on how to correctly set up the artwork for media walls

Please use an appropriate program such as Adobe InDesign or Illustrator to format your media wall artwork. If you do not have InDesign or Illustrator then it is best to ask UniPrint to design your banners for you.

A pdf template is available to use as a guide.

The frame size of the 2.3m curved media wall is 2.28m wide x 2.20m high. Artwork is to be setup to 2430mm wide x 2260mm tall as this accomodates for the stretch in the material. Please avoid text and important imagery outside the safe

margin area (60mm all around) where the fabric wraps around the frame curvature. This template can also be used for the double sided media walls.

When formatting the document and providing the finished file for printing, please remember the following:

- Background colours or images are to extend to the edge of the design area;
- Text and logos are to be kept within the safe guide in the design area to avoid cropping;

- Text minimum size is 30pt and must be converted to paths/outlines;
- Photographic images are to be at least 100dpi at the finished size, and are to be in CMYK;
- Logos are to be vector in CMYK or Pantone;
- Supply the artwork at 100% size;
- Supply the artwork as a print-quality pdf file, as an Illustrator file, or eps;
- Bleed and trim marks are not required.

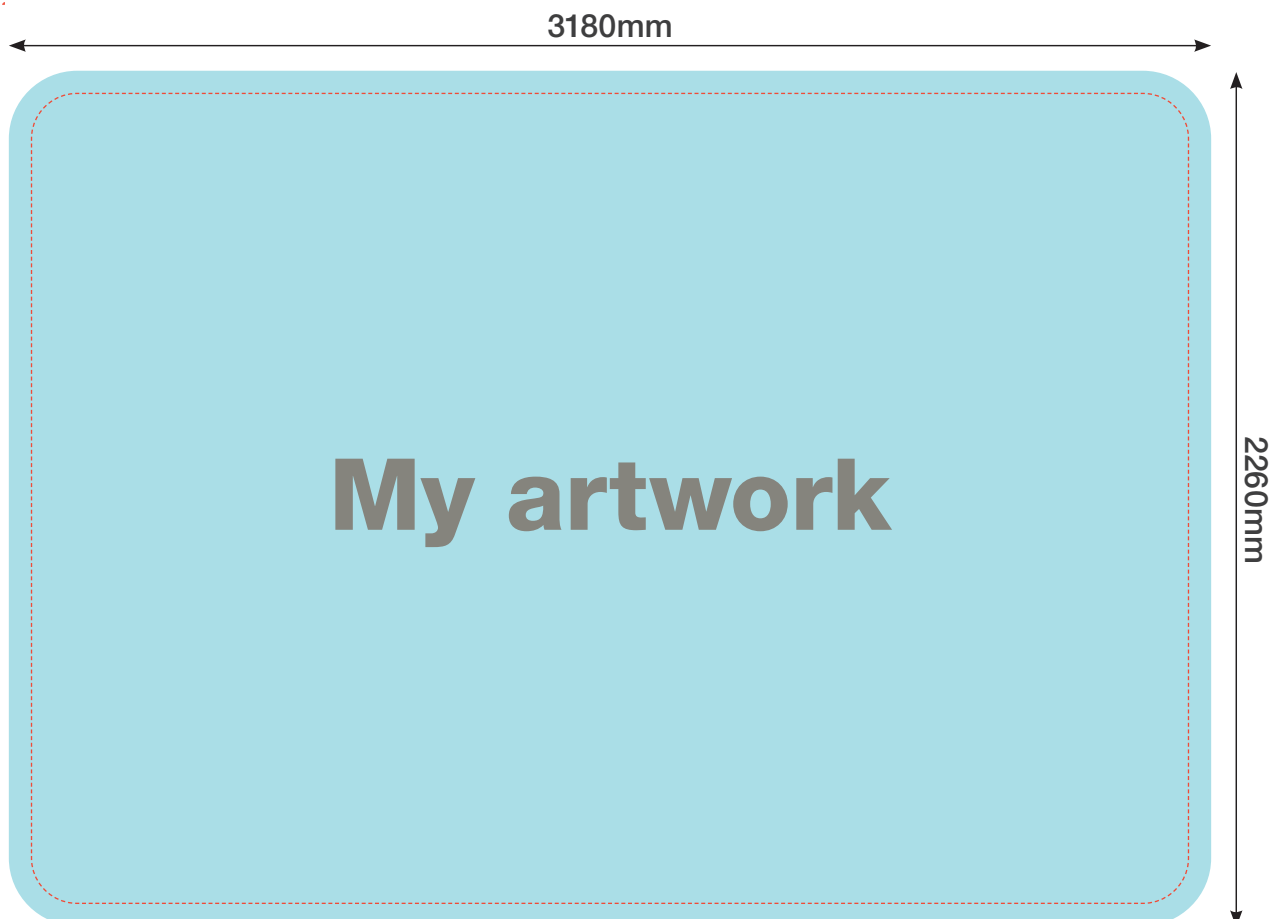
The frame size of the 3m curved media wall is 3m wide x 2.2m high. Artwork is to be setup to 3180mm wide x 2260mm tall as this accomodates for the stretch in the material. Please avoid text and important imagery outside the safe margin area

(60mm all around) where the fabric wraps around the frame curvature. This template can also be used for the double sided media walls.

When formatting the document and providing the finished file for printing, please remember the following:

- Background colours or images are to extend to the edge of the design area;
- Text and logos are to be kept within the safe guide in the design area to avoid cropping;

- Text minimum size is 30pt and must be converted to paths/outlines;
- Photographic images are to be at least 100dpi at the finished size, and are to be in CMYK;
- Logos are to be vector in CMYK or Pantone;
- Supply the artwork at 100% size;
- Supply the artwork as a print-quality pdf file, as an Illustrator file, or eps;
- Bleed and trim marks are not required.

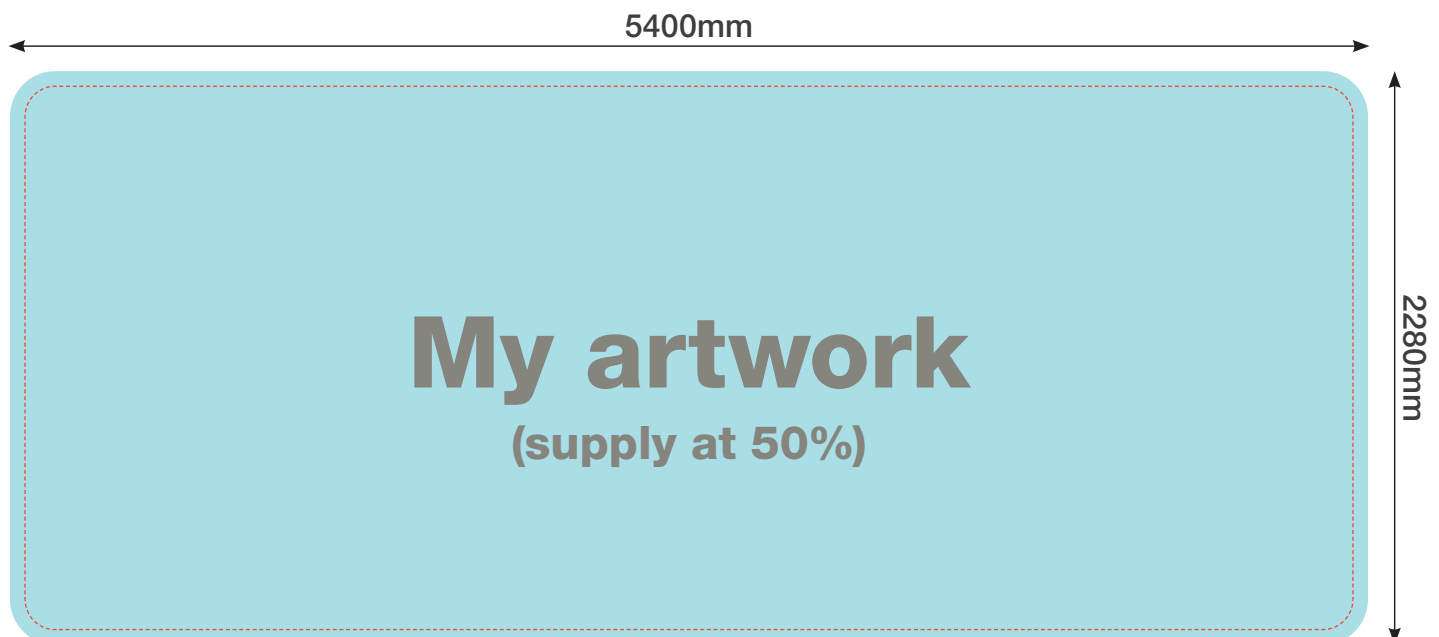

(60mm all around) where the fabric wraps around the frame curvature. This template can also be used for the double sided media walls.

When formatting the document and providing the finished file for printing, please remember the following:

- Background colours or images are to extend to the edge of the design area;
- Text and logos are to be kept within the safe guide in the design area to avoid cropping;

- Text minimum size is 30pt and must be converted to paths/outlines;

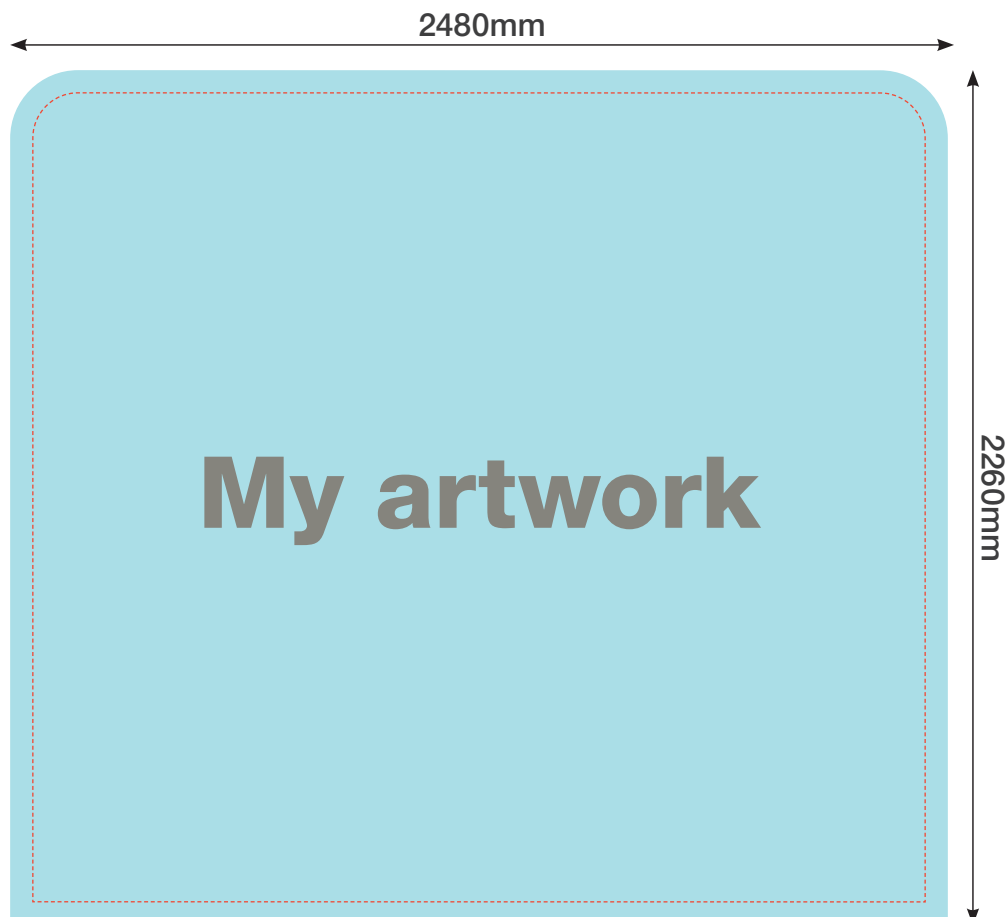

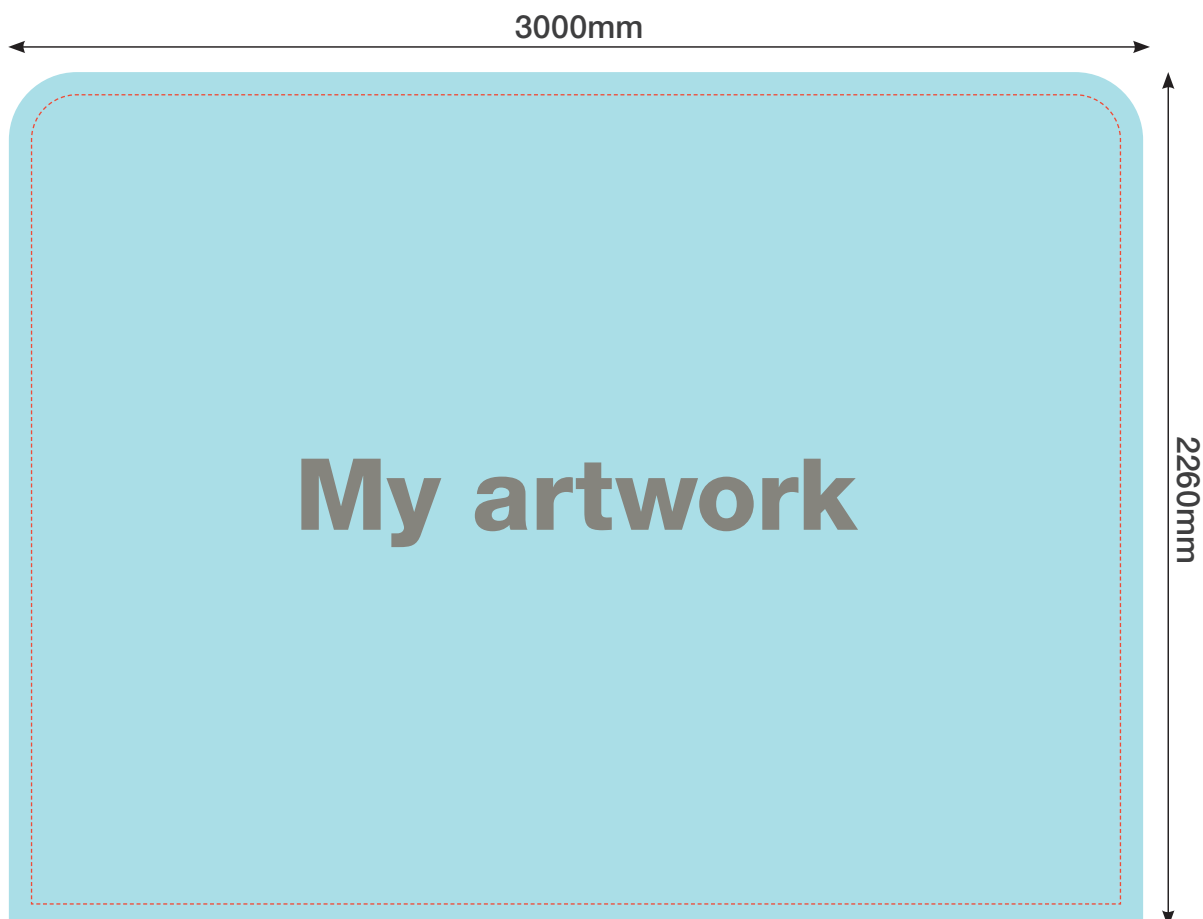
